



The Satisfaction Survey Report on the Project of Social Adaptation with Sports

4th Quarter Report

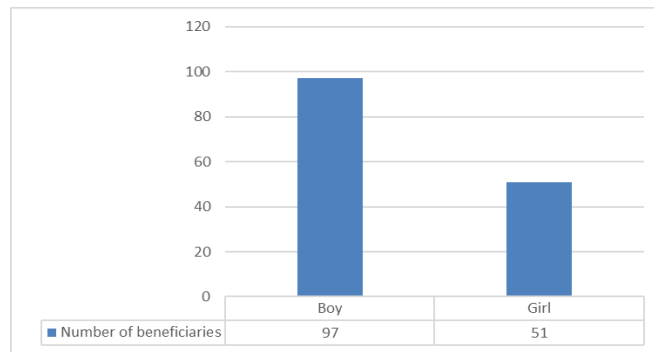
Two studies have been carried out in order to determine the satisfaction situation of the beneficiaries participating in the studies done within the scope of the Project of social adaptation with sports as conducted in the previous reporting periods.

As in the previous quarters; the aim of the first study was to find out the problems faced during the period and increase the quality of the studies. The aim of the second one was to obtain the preliminary information for the following studies by determining the satisfaction situation at the end of the period. The sample of the research has been determined as simple random and applied as not less than 10% of each group. Because of the small sampling, the outcomes of the research have been visualized and reported by giving frequencies. In the second study done, 4 closed ended questions including the participants' demographic information and 6 closed ended questions on satisfaction have been asked. Starring method has been used in 6 questions in order to enable the children to answer more easily. Furthermore, the uncertain choice has been added when they are uncertain to answer.

Demographic Distribution

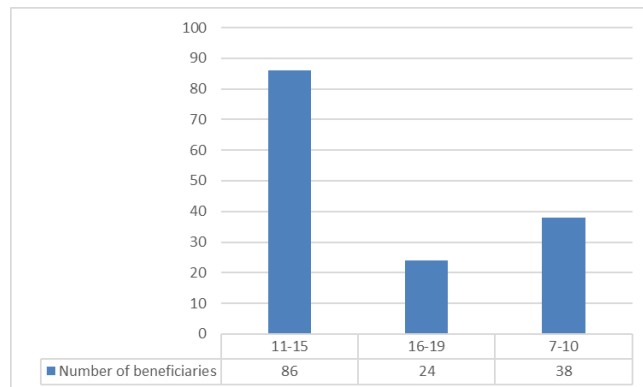
148 Beneficiaries in total have participated in the study at the end of the term. These participants' gender, age, province and nationality distribution are as follows.

The beneficiaries participating in the satisfaction survey are about 34 % girls and 66 % boys.

The beneficiaries participating in the satisfaction survey are about 26 % aged 7-10, 58% aged 11-15 and 16% aged 16-19.



Table 3: The city distribution of the beneficiaries participating in the Satisfaction Survey of the Project of Social adaption for Sport

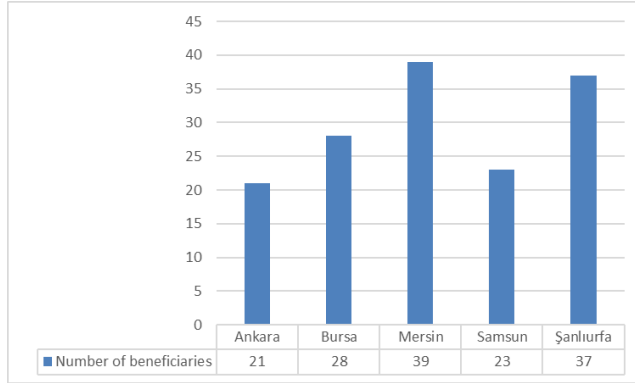
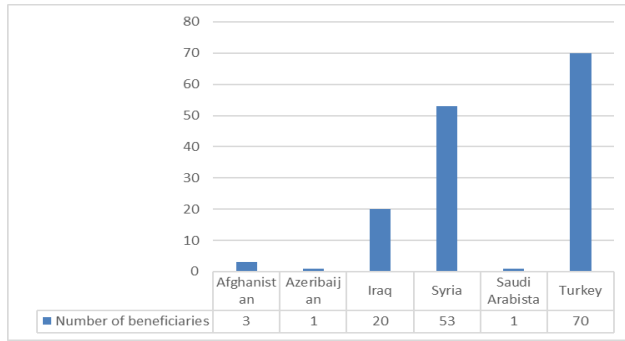


Table 4: The Distribution of the beneficiaries participating in the Satisfaction Survey of the Project of Social adaption for Sports according to their nationalities

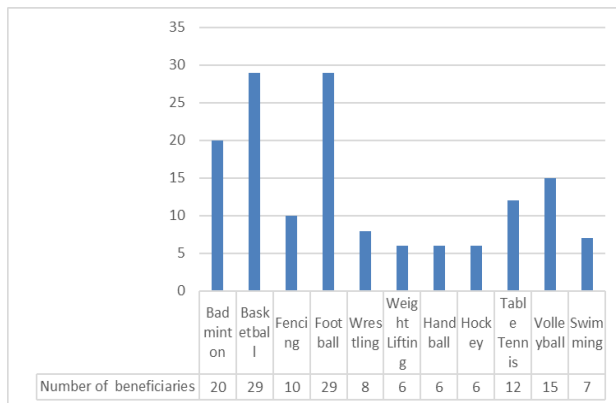


The beneficiaries participating in the Satisfaction Survey are about 2 % from Afghanistan, 1% from Azerbaijan, 14 % from Iraq, 36 % from Syria, 1% from Saudi Arabia and 47% from Turkey.

Satisfaction Survey Results

In the Satisfaction Survey, the beneficiaries were asked 6 questions following the demographic information and they were desired to answer the suitable one of 1, 2 and 3 star or uncertain answers. The persons answering “uncertain” were calculated as “0 star”. The 6 questions in the Satisfaction Survey and the distribution of the beneficiaries according to the sports branches were shown in detail below.

Table 5: The distribution of the beneficiaries participating in the Satisfaction Survey of the Project of Social adaption for Sports according to sports branches

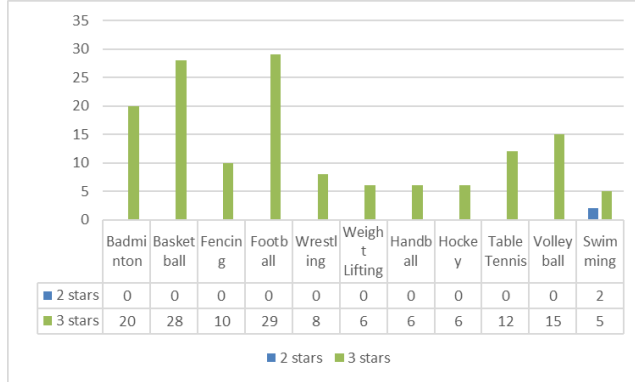


The beneficiaries participating in the Satisfaction Survey joined the following sports branches: about 14% Badminton, 20 % Basketball, 7 % Fencing, 20%

Football, 5 % Wrestling, 4% handball, 4% hockey, 4% tabel tennis, 8% table tennis, 10% volleyball and 5% swimming.

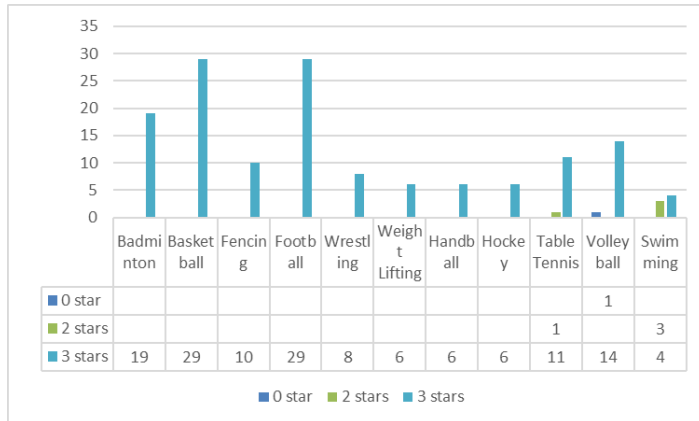


Table 6: The distribution of the reaction given to the sentence "I liked participating in this course"



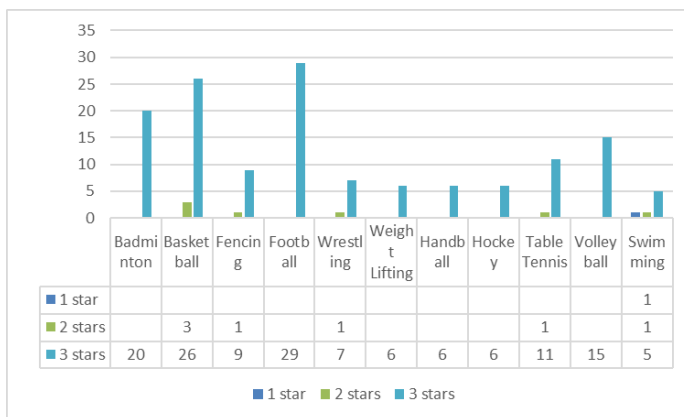
Almost all the children participating in the activities stated that they liked the course that they joined. Only two of them said that he did not like swimming so much. Therefore, it can be deduced that the children had a connection with the course they attended even in the middle of the activities.

Table 7: The distribution of the reaction given to the sentence "I can advise this course to my friends too."



96% of the children participating in the activities stated that they would advise this course to their friends.

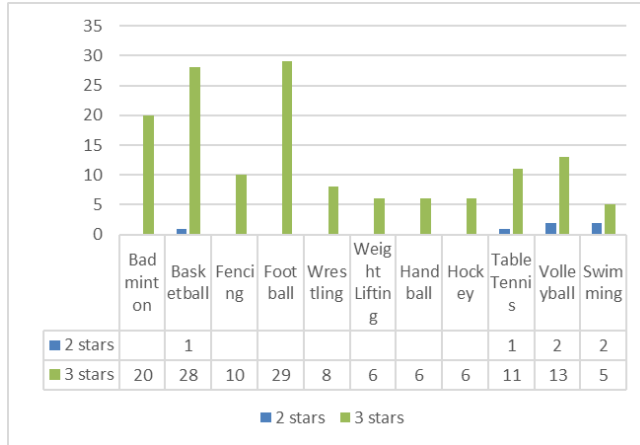
Table 8: The distribution of the reaction given to the sentence "I like doing sports more because of this course"



Most of the children (about 95 %) participating in the activities stated that they liked doing sports more. It was observed that 7 children (3 Basketball, 1 Fencing, 1 Wrestling, 1 Table tennis and 1 Football) do not agree with the idea that they like doing sports more so much.

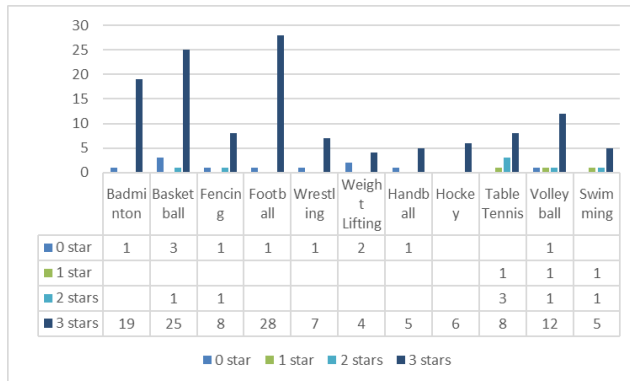


Table 9: The distribution of the reaction given to the sentence “The course officials and coaches have a good relationship with me”.



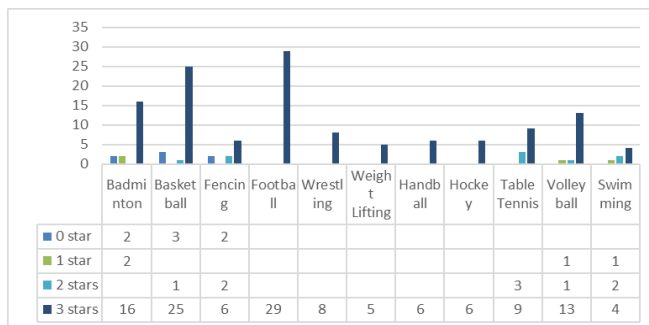
Most of the children (about 96 %) participating in the activities stated that the educators behaved politely and respectfully towards them in the first term of the course and added that they could express themselves well. There were not any children who stated the course officials and courses do not have a good relation with them.

Table 10: The distribution of the reaction given to the sentence “I think of going to the Youth Centres /Sports Facilities after this course too”.



Most of the children (about 86 %) participating in the activities stated that they would go to the Youth Centres /Sports Facilities after this course ended too. 11 children were uncertain.

Table 11: The distribution of the reaction given to the sentence “I have had information about the youth and sports services in our country by this course”.



Most of the children (about 86 %) participating in the activities stated that they had had information about the youth and sports services in our country by this course. 9 children said that they do not agree with this sentence so much (with 2 stars) and 4 children (with 1 star) and also 7 children were uncertain about this sentence. The answers’ disaggregation by branches might be Table 11.

Evaluation



Via this satisfaction survet carried out at the end of the period, the outcomes might be summarized as below:

Most of the beneficiaries liked the course (96%), they would advise to their friends (95%), they liked doing sports more (95%) and they were pleased with the behaviour of the officials (96%). 86 % of the participants stated that they had had information about the youth and sports services in our country by this course.
