



# The Satisfaction Survey Report on the Project of Social Adaptation with Sports

## 4th Quarter Report

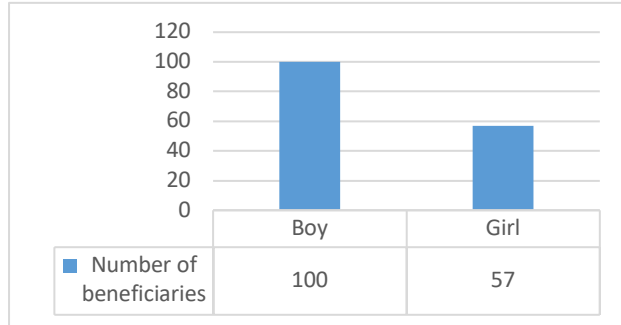
Two studies have been carried out in order to determine the satisfaction situation of the beneficiaries participating in the studies done within the scope of the Project of social adaptation with sports as conducted in the previous reporting periods.

As in the previous quarters; the aim of the first study was to find out the problems faced during the period and increase the quality of the studies. The aim of the second one was to obtain the preliminary information for the following studies by determining the satisfaction situation at the end of the period. The sample of the research has been determined as simple random and applied as not less than 10% of each group. Because of the small sampling, the outcomes of the research have been visualized and reported by giving frequencies. In the second study done, 4 closed ended questions including the participants' demographic information and 6 closed ended questions on satisfaction have been asked. Starring method has been used in 6 questions in order to enable the children to answer more easily. Furthermore, the uncertain choice has been added when they are uncertain to answer.

### Demographic Distribution

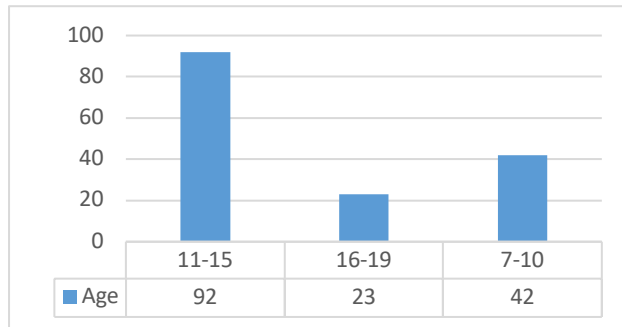
157 Beneficiaries in total have participated in the study realized between the term. These participants' gender, age, city and nationality distribution are as follows.

Table 1: The gender distribution of the beneficiaries participating in the satisfaction survey conducted within the scope of the Social adaption with Sports



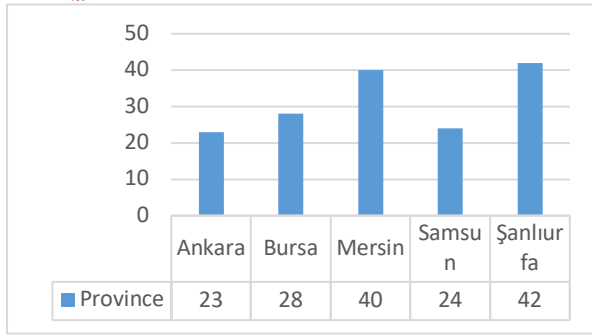
The beneficiaries participating in the satisfaction survey are about 36 % girls and 64 % boys.

Table 2: The age distribution of the beneficiaries participating in the satisfaction survey conducted within the scope of the Social adaption with Sports



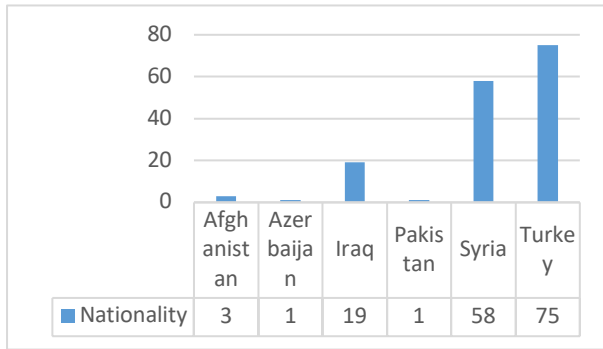
The beneficiaries participating in the satisfaction survey are about 27 % aged 7-10, 59% aged 11-15 and 15% aged 16-19.

The beneficiaries participating in the satisfaction survey are about 15 % of Ankara, 18% of Bursa, 25% of Mersin, 15 % of Samsun and 27% of Şanlıurfa.

The beneficiaries participating in the Satisfaction Survey are about 2% Afghanistan, 1% Azerbaijan, 12% Iraq, 1% Pakistan, 37% Syria and 48% Turkey.

### **Satisfaction Survey Results**

In the Satisfaction Survey, the beneficiaries were asked 6 questions following the demographic information and they were desired to answer the suitable one of 1, 2 and 3 star or uncertain answers. The persons answering "uncertain" were calculated as "0 star". The 6 questions in the Satisfaction Survey and the distribution of the beneficiaries according to the sports branches were shown in detail below.

Table 5: The distribution of the beneficiaries participating in the Satisfaction Survey of the Project of Social adaptation for Sports according to sports branches

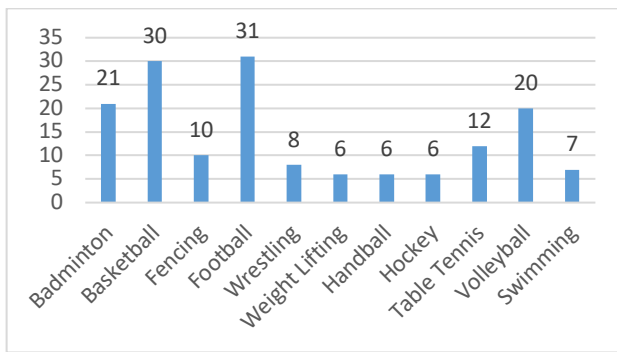
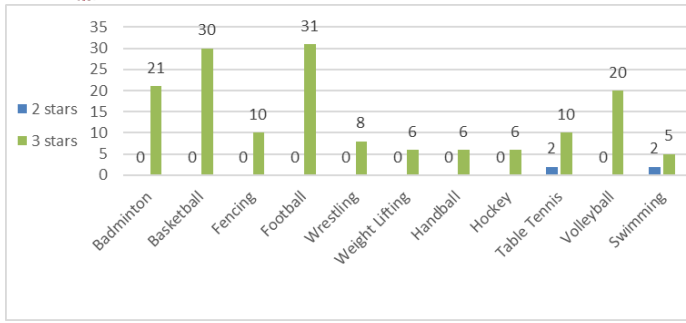
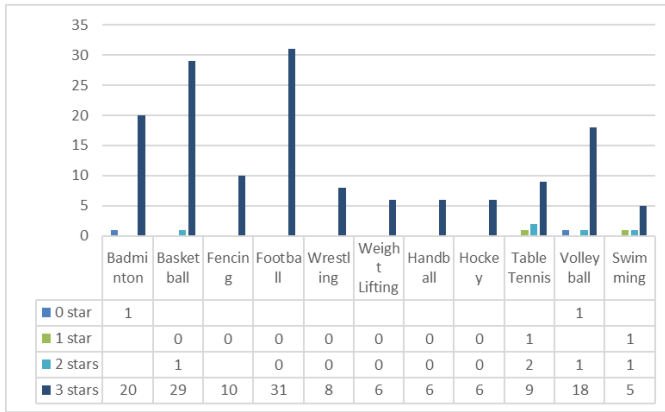


Table 6: The distribution of the reaction given to the sentence "I liked participating in this course"



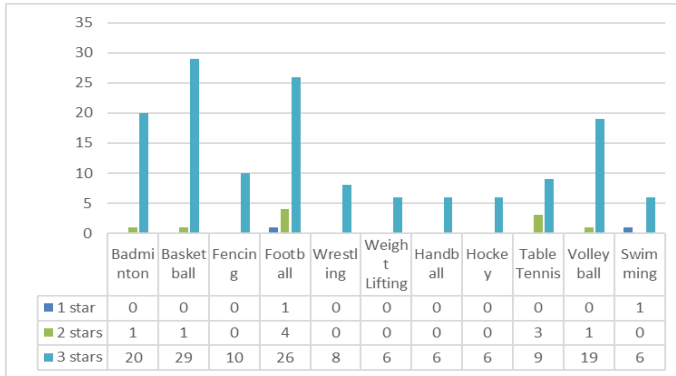
Almost all the children (98 %) participating in the activities stated that they liked the course that they joined.

Table 7: The distribution of the reaction given to the sentence "I can advise this course to my friends too."



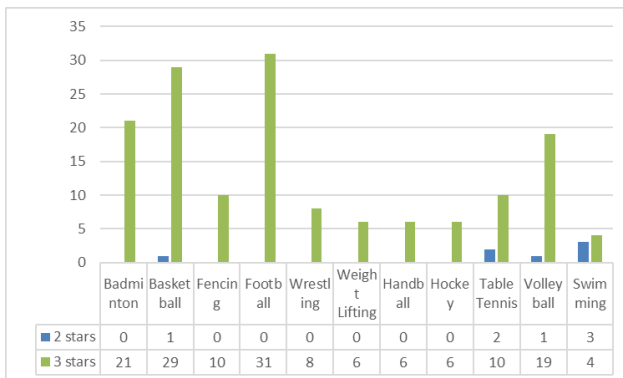
94% of the children participating in the activities stated that they would advise this course to their friends. It was observed that just 4 children stated that they do not agree with the idea of advising the course or uncertain (1 from volleyball, 1 from table tennis, 1 from badminton and 1 from swimming).

Table 8: The distribution of the reaction given to the sentence "I like doing sports more because of this course".



Most of the children (about 93 %) participating in the activities stated that they liked doing sports more. 2 children from football and swimming do not agree with the idea that they like doing sports more so much.

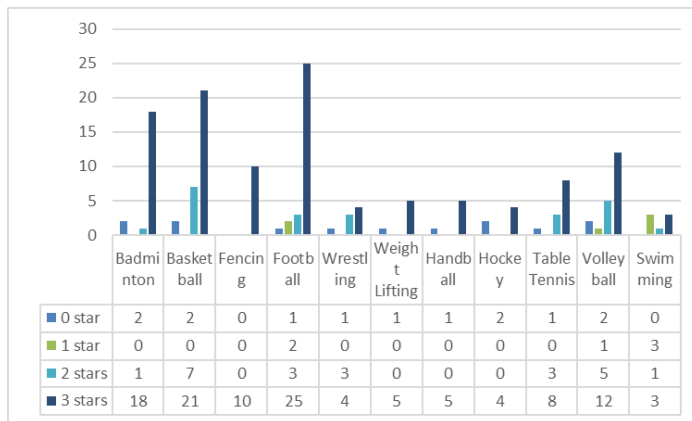
Table 9: The distribution of the reaction given to the sentence "The course officials and coaches have a good relationship with me".



96% of the children participating in the activities stated that the educators behaved politely and respectfully towards them in the first term of the course and added that they could express themselves well.

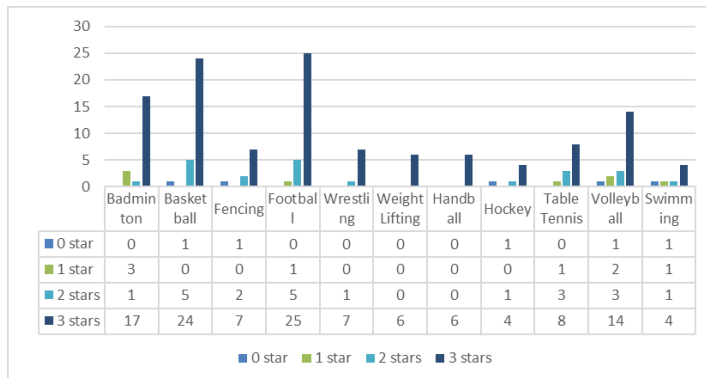


Table 10: The distribution of the reaction given to the sentence “I think of going to the Youth Centres /Sports Facilities after this course too”.



Most of the children (about 73 %) participating in the activities stated that they would go to the Youth Centres /Sports Facilities after this course ended too. 23 children said that they do not agree with this sentence so much (with 2 stars) and 13 children (with 1 star) and also 5 children were uncertain about this sentence.

Table 11: The distribution of the reaction given to the sentence “I have had information about the youth and sports services in our country by this course”.



Most of the children (about 78%) participating in the activities stated that they had had information about the youth and sports services in our country by this course. 22 children said that they do not agree with this sentence so much (with 2 stars) and 8 children (with 1 star) about this sentence.

### Evaluation

The project’s success is planned to measure via attendance, satisfaction and change in state of well-beings. Within the scope of this, the satisfaction survey has been carried out in two steps and according to the outcomes of the survey the main findings are:

- 98% of the children stated that they liked the course,
- 93% of the children like doing sports more because of this course,
- 96% of the participants said the educators had a good relationship with them.
- 78% of the children had information about the youth and sports services.



- 73% of the children would come centers after the course.

This could be deduced that most of the children liked the courses and the courses have changed their attitude to the sports.
